BROOKS WILLIAMS

At the crossroads of blues and American roots music you'll find **Brooks Williams**. "Setting new standards and a fresh direction for the blues," says *Blues In Britain*, and creating a "beautiful fusion" (*Keys And Chords*). Just when you think he can't sing a blues-ier note, he sings it. Just when you think he can't strum a deeper groove, he strums it.

He's no slouch as a songwriter, and has an impeccable ear for a good cover. "Williams' original songs are typically sophisticated musically, and yet sound immediately familiar – a sign of a skilled songwriter", writes *Down At The Crossroads*. His massive repertoire spans classic roots and blues. Williams is at the top of his game. He loves performing, and that love exudes from every note.

Scott Engstrom, our always engaging host of the monthly Open Stage, will open the evening. Scott is an accomplished songwriter, finger-style guitarist and bluegrass/clawhammer banjoist. Playing a varied mix of tunes from a cross section of rural America's musical past, Blind Squirrel will entertain and energize you with memorable melodies, deep stories and a boisterous beat. We are certainly looking forward to their inaugural performance at the Lake County Folk Club!

OPENING: JIM SCHRAMM

Opening the evening's concert will be folk club member Jim Schramm, an engaging singer/guitarist who takes an "everyman" perspective and has an eloquent way with songs of social commentary and light-hearted satire. Jim's wide repertoire has an emphasis on that "Chicago sound" heard in the clubs along Lincoln Avenue during the heyday of the windy city folk scene.

Open Stage / Second Sundays

The second Sunday of each month is our Open Stage night, hosted by Scott Engstrom. Come out and enjoy some great local musical talent! Non-performing listeners are always encouraged and will be pleasantly surprised with the diverse musical styles represented. There's a little something for everyone.

Anyone who would like to perform is encouraged to do so.

You'll never find a more supportive audience than at the LCFC. Sign-up begins at 6:30 PM and the music starts at 7:00. Each performer is allowed up to two songs spanning about 10 minutes. If time permits—and it often does—artists can perform an additional song near evening's end. (suggested \$3 donation)



Song Circle / Fourth Sundays

On the fourth Sunday of each month we hold our Song Circle. Members and non-members are always welcome. Come out to sing, play, or just listen.

Marcia Krieger, along with other members of the LCFC, hosts our Song Circle. It's a casual opportunity to kick back, play some music and meet others. Participants form a circle and each one in turn can choose to play a song or pass. It's a chance to lead songs or to join in with others. We are thrilled to (occasionally) present a special Behind the Song concert, hosted by Chuck VanderVennet. These unique events are an intimate exploration of the personal craft of songwriting from one artist's perspective.
